Longwood Gardens Christmas Bus Trip Open to All!!!!

What better way to put you in the holiday spirit as a visit to Longwood Gardens in Kennett Square, PA? Take a break from the commercialism of the holiday and enjoy the peace and beauty of nature, dressed for the season. Poinsettias, magnificent trees, and fragrant flowers transform the Conservatory into a holiday wonderland. Outside, colorful fountains dance to festive music, strolling carolers herald the season with song, and a half-million twinkling lights await. If this sounds amazing, join us for the day trip. This



trip is open to everyone. We will travel by private chartered bus. Please note, the gardens require a lot of standing and walking.

Cost without supervision: \$75—This includes bus transportation, group leader, and admission to the gardens. Approval for recreation participants to attend at this level is at the discretion of recreation staff.

Cost with supervision: \$115—This includes bus transportation, \$20 gift card toward a meal at the gardens, admission, and staff supervision at a 1 to 4 ratio.

Mark your calendars for the last week of October in 2019 for the most amazing experience. Go to greatescapelakeside.com to check out a similar house. The house that we are renting is brand new and will be finished in early Spring, 2019.

This is a gigantic 15 Bedroom home featuring a themed game in every room. The 10 acre property includes a huge concrete "human board game" outside surrounded by other games, like giant Yahtzee and giant Battleship! This will be like having our own private resort!

The house opens in spring 2019 and is located just outside of Orlando and Disney Parks. This trip will offer the best of the best. A visit to one Disney or Universal Theme Park and a 4-night stay in the most amazing house. The house also offers our own movie theater, night club, laser tag, karaoke, life size games, skee ball, human bowling, etc. The beautiful grounds offer many life-sized outdoor games, an outdoor kitchen, billiard-shaped pool and lazy river, and a campfire area in a park-like setting.

Please indicate on the Registration Page the programs and special events that you are interested in attending. DO NOT SEND IN ANY MONEY AT THIS TIME! We will notify you through a letter to indicate which programs you are confirmed for and which ones you are on the waiting list for. The Recreation staff has final approval for participation in all events. Please do not pay online via credit card until you have received confirmation.

Cancellation

If fewer than the minimum participants register for a program, it may be cancelled. A program reimbursement or credit will be issued. Refunds are not guaranteed for any program. If the individual cancels for a program, he or she must give at least three days notice for a refund for a ticketed event, and 24 hours notice for a non-ticketed event. Please note that in the event of a cancellation, we may not be able to refund your money.

Inclement Weather

In the event of poor or questionable weather, call our office for updated information an hour and a half prior to the scheduled time of the event.

Our phone number is (732) 493-0225. When the program is cancelled, a message will be left on the machine. If the agency is closed due to bad weather, all programs during that time will also be cancelled.

Transportation

Limited transportation is available for some of the special events for those individuals who have no other means of transportation. There is a small fee when transportation services are utilized.

If financial assistance is needed in order to participate in a program, special event, or vacations, please call the Recreation Dept. We will set up a payment plan if one is needed. Full sponsorships are also available. If you need financial assistance, please contact the recreation office. We will send you a sponsorship application to complete and return.
