This location hosts a large gym/recreation center, a therapeutic gym, two well equipped sensory rooms and a gross motor skills room. Each of the three programs located at Campus Parkway has a teaching kitchen, art room, classroom, and a computer room in addition to multi-purpose rooms. Services can include occupational therapy, speech therapy and physical therapy. Therapy animals also visit the participants once a month.

Eatontown Achievement Center

A Day habilitation center that caters to a wide variety of needs, abilities, and strengths. Individuals follow a daily schedule in which they have input. Activities include but are not limited to arts & crafts, technology, educational skills, math and money skills, social skills, strategic thinking, self-advocacy, music & movement, housekeeping, cooking, health and wellness, and community integration. This center accepts all tier levels including clients with some behavioral or medical needs.

Green Grove Achievement Center

A specialized center for adults with dual diagnoses of developmental disabilities and mental illness or behavioral disorders. Periodically, individuals who are transitioning from instructional settings and present with more challenging behavior attend the Green Grove AC. This center offers a structured and supportive environment for those working towards developing social awareness, social skills, and self-regulation to further their independence in the community. This includes working on anger management, replacing maladaptive behaviors with healthy behaviors, stress management, self-advocacy, calming techniques, and safety awareness. An added benefit to GGAC is a higher staff to participant ratio to provide more specialized support. Staff work closely with a Board-Certified Behavior Analyst (BCBA) and with Clinical Behavioral Technicians (RBTs) to conduct functional behavioral assessment, develop, implement behavior plans.

Shore Achievement Center

Specialized Medical Day Habilitation Center for adults with severe or profound developmental disabilities and physical disabilities. A significant percentage of clients who attend this program utilize wheelchairs and walkers, have a specialized or modified diet, and require complete assistance with all Activities of Daily Living including ostomy care if needed. There is a nurse on staff to assist with all g-tube feedings and medical situations. All staff receive additional training, which may include but are not limited to: Hoyer Lifts, Safe Feeding, Specialized Diets, Positioning, Seizure Protocol and Wheelchair tiedowns while transporting in vehicles.
