

A solar eclipse will happen on Monday, August 21, 2017 in the afternoon



What is a solar eclipse?

The moon will pass in front of the sun on Monday afternoon, starting at about 1 pm, blocking out the sun. It will be dark outside, like it is at night. By about 4:00 pm on Monday, the darkness will end outside, and it will be light outside again.

- DO NOT LOOK AT THE SKY DURING THE ECLIPSE UNLESS YOU HAVE SPECIAL SUNGLASSES.
- IF YOU LOOK AT THE SKY DURING THE ECLIPSE, YOUR EYE SIGHT COULD BE DAMAGED PERMANENTLY!
- DON'T WEAR REGULAR SUNGLASSES TO WATCH THE SKY DURING THE ECLIPSE. REGULAR SUNGLASSES WILL NOT PROTECT YOUR EYES.
