Competitive Employment – What is This?

Competitive Employment is either full time or part time work where individuals are compensated for their work in an integrated setting. Compensation or wages must be paid at or above the state minimum wage, and no less than the wages paid to their coworkers who do not have a disability who perform the same or similar work.

# Competitive Employment - Why Work?

- · Gain new skills
- · Participate in your community
- Earn money potential to earn more than SSD/SSDI benefit checks can provide while you maintain Medicaid
- Meet new people and make new friends
- · Improve your quality of life
- Improve your self esteem

#### INDEPENDENCE!

What is Supported Employment? Services that individuals who live with disabilities are entitled to when obtaining and maintain employment.

NJ is an "Employment First State"

- Individuals need to "opt out" of work rather than "opt in"
- Presumes people can and should work



## Long-Term Support

- Long-Term Support is provided for individuals who are considered "stabilized" on their job. A Job Coach is still available, however will not attend work during each shift. This is called fading.
- LTFA can be provided through DVR, however for individuals who are eligible for DDD services, longterm supported is funded through their individual budgets.

What is NOT Considered Supported Employment?

- 100% presence from a Job Coach
- Safety monitoring
- Transportation services
- Assistance with volunteer work


